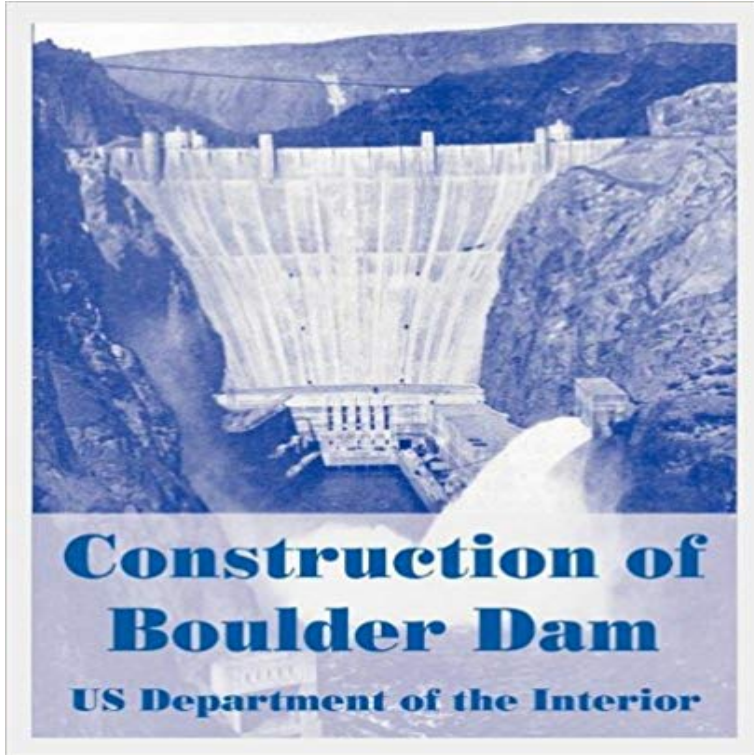


Construction of Boulder Dam
